HURRICANE PREPARATION PLAN

Executive Board

- 1) Identify hurricane team
- 2) Track storm
- 3) Determine timetable to have club prepared
- 4) Notify the membership of the hurricane plan and their responsibilities
- 5) Notify the membership that the team will be authorized to board all boats to secure them to the adjacent boats, across the basin, and to the trees behind the boats.

Membership Individual Responsibilities

- a) Remove power and water from their boats,
- b) Emptying their refrigerator and shut down all power in the boat,
- c) Remove all sources of windage, bimini enclosures, cockpit enclosures etc.
- d) Members that are not able to assist in securing their boats should leave heavy lines and fenders visible for the team to secure their boat.
- e) Dinghies and dinghies on trailers must be removed from all boats and PYC.
- f) Members on creek slips must prepare their own boats for the surge and wind or remove them from the PYC and go to a more secure location.
- g) Boats on the outboard slips should be removed from the water and PYC property.
- h) All member picnic benches must be secured to trees.

Club house

- ✓ Locate portable generator / gas
- ✓ Several gallons of drinking water (drinking & toilet)
- ✓ Food, can goods, coffee, milk, cooler etc.
- ✓ Flashlights
- ✓ Lantern
- ✓ Boots
- ✓ Duck tape (several rolls)
- ✓ Plywood for windows
- ✓ Dry clothes
- ✓ First Aid Kit
- ✓ Aspirins, IB's
- ✓ Cell phone
- ✓ VHF radios
- ✓ Portable radios & portable TV
- ✓ Extension cords
- ✓ Gas powered water pump if available

Grounds and Committees

- ✓ Move tractor to pavilion.
- ✓ Tie up picnic benches under pavilion.
- ✓ Move deck chairs, tables & umbrellas to the down stairs.
- ✓ Turn off all power and water in the basin and creek.
- ✓ PYC gas tank should be secured, electrical wiring and hoses should be removed.
- ✓ Gas dock should be secured?
